Students practise curriculum skills independently, receive immediate feedback and strengthen areas that need further development.



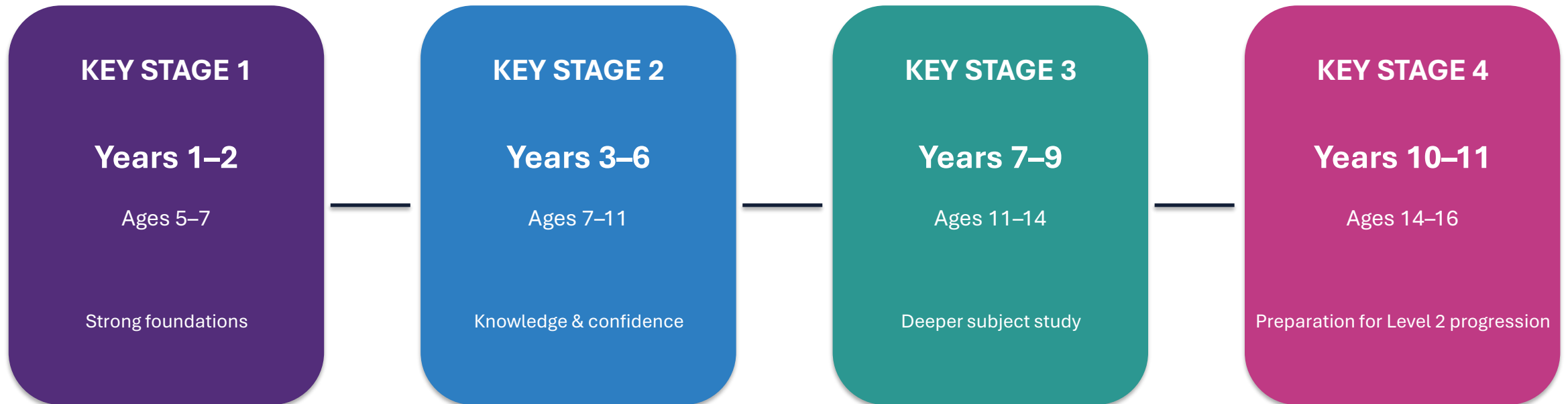
Independent Study

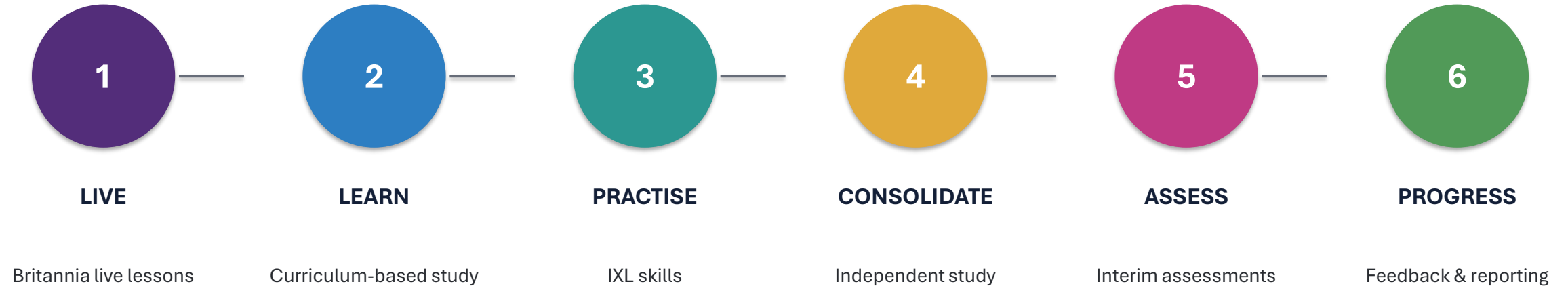
From Year 1 to Year 11

How learning works

Core live learning

Mathematics

Global Citizenship

Communities, cultures, global issues, responsibility and an interconnected world.

Assessment & academic progress

Three formal Interim Assessment periods each academic year.

Assessments may include objective questions, written responses, problem-solving and subject-specific tasks.

Results are considered alongside class participation, assignments, independent work and ongoing teacher assessment.

Key Stage completion milestones

Additional standardised assessment at the end of Years 6 and 9.

Year 6 — Completion of Key Stage 2

Students completing Year 6 sit an Oxford standardised assessment to provide an additional independent measure of attainment at the end of Key Stage 2.

Year 6 → Oxford Standardised Assessment → Year 7



Year 9 — Completion of Key Stage 3

Students completing Year 9 sit an Oxford standardised assessment to provide an additional independent measure of attainment at the end of Key Stage 3.

Year 9 → Oxford Standardised Assessment → Year 10



Britannia's internal assessment cycle and standardised milestone assessments work together to provide a broader picture of student attainment.

External Qualifications

Functional Skills and Level 2 / Level 3 Diplomas are separately registered qualifications with their own admission, registration, assessment and awarding requirements.

Completing Year 11 provides progression into appropriate qualification pathways; Year 11 itself is not presented as an external Level 2 qualification.

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
